

Butternut Squash PASTINA





abies just starting out with solid foods, toddlers, kids, and full grown adults can all enjoy this meal. It really is for everyone! When my kids were babies, I always made them homemade baby food. Pastina is one of the foods I used to feed them. It's soft and tiny enough for them to mush together with their little gums. The butternut squash gives them the veggies they need and they will love the sweet flavor! But like I said, it's not just for babies! I made this for my family and we all enjoyed it with a salad on the side.

First, roast the squash. Wash the outside of the skin and dry it, then poke holes all over with a fork or knife. Lay the whole squash on an aluminum foil lined cookie sheet and bake at 400 degrees for about 50 minutes. When the middle of the squash is soft, remove it from the oven and let it cool. Once the squash is cooled, cut it in half the long way and remove the seeds and "guts". Peel the skin off and cut the squash into cubes.

In a large pot, heat a little olive oil over med-high heat. Simmer one clove of minced garlic, 1/2 of a chopped onion, 1 cup of chopped carrots, and 1 cup of chopped celery until tender. Add the cubed roasted butternut squash and season with salt, pepper, and nutmeg. Add just enough chicken broth to the pot to cover all of the above ingredients. Once it begins boiling, cover the pot, turn the heat down to low and simmer until all of the vegetables are soft.

With an immersion blender, blend the soup right in the pot itself until it is smooth and all of the chunks are gone. If you don't have an immersion blender, ladle the soup into a blender once it has cooled and blend. In a separate small pot, bring salted water to a boil and cook pastina according to instructions. Drain the pastina once it's cooked.

Spoon some of the pastina into a bowl and add the butternut squash soup. How much to add depends on the consistency you'd like. You can make it as thick or as soupy as you'd like.

Mix together and enjoy!
